

# Proceedings: Conference on Mango in Hawaii

This three-day conference held March 9–11, 1993, was organized to discuss a wide range of subjects related to mango. It was the first major treatment of the subject in Hawaii in 40 years, and the proceedings remains the most comprehensive document available for Hawaii's unique conditions.
